1 WHEREAS the Student Government Association of Drury University is the
2 official voice of the students, and
3
4 RECOGNIZING that the lack of sufficient lighting behind the residence halls
5 on Calhoun Street is a potential danger to the numerous students that walk that
6 route at night, and
7
8 NOTING that 57% of respondents to the Fall 2005 Day School Student Survey
9 stated that they would like to see improved lighting at night on Calhoun Street,
10 and
11
12 NOTING that Drury University “is committed to maintaining an academic and
13 social environment conducive to intellectual and personal development of
14 students and to the safety and welfare of all members of the campus
15 community,”¹
16
17 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the 2006-2007 SGA
18 General Assembly recommend that the lack of lighting on Calhoun Street be
19 addressed as a serious concern by members of Drury University administration.
