1 WHEREAS the Student Government Association of Drury University is the
2 official voice of the students, and
3
4 ACKNOWLEDGING the increasing importance of taking a leadership
5 position in sustainable efforts in the Springfield and global community;

7 FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGING that the student body is receptive to using
8 student fees to execute sustainable initiatives;

10 UNDERSTANDING that any increase to student fees for this cause would
11 need to be reasonable and affordable;

13 RECOGNIZING the function of the existing President's Council on
14 Sustainability and that it operates with adequate student representation;

16 NOTING that while any increase of fees will be bundled within the current
17 student fees, sustainable initiatives should be listed on the tuition bill as an
18 attribute of the student fee;

20 FURTHER NOTING that day school students should not be the only body
21 contributing to a fund for sustainable initiatives within the Drury community;

23 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Student Government
24 Association of Drury University, recommend the implementation of a student
25 sustainability fee that meets the said criteria is allocated for use by the
26 President's Council on Sustainability.
