1 WHEREAS the Student Government Association of Drury University is the official voice
2 of the students, and

4 WHEREAS accessibility on campus is a concern of the Student Body of Drury
5 University,

7 ACKNOWLEDGING five of the buildings on Drury University's campus are not
8 accessible to students belonging to Drury University's population with physical
9 handicaps,

10

11 RECOGNIZING those buildings as the Breech School of Business, Burnham Hall, Smith
12 Dormitory, Mabee Performing Arts Center, and the Findlay Student Center,

14 FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGING that the Survey of Diversity and Inclusion from
15 2010 shows that students responded with 17.3% (30 students) disagreeing, and 8.7% (15
16 students) believing that Drury does not thoroughly address campus issues related to
17 disability concerns,

19 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Student Government Association of
20 Drury University, shall compose a letter to be sent to Todd Parnell, President of Drury
21 University to show the Student Body's concern for the attitude Drury University
22 expresses in accordance to accessibility.
